Mission

Our goal is to teach the children about God and His plan for their lives. During Bible classes a specific subject and related scripture verses are taught. Biblical concepts are integrated into the daily academic lessons as well, to help the children see the relationship to biblical principles in their everyday lives. The end result will be children who are confident in who they are in Christ, who understand their responsibility for their own actions, and who are learning to make good decisions for themselves as well as toward others.

We are dedicated to educating and preparing our students to grow spiritually and to achieve academically. Our goal is excellence in all areas of the program. The integration of God's Word into an academically challenging educational program allows students to see the world from a Christ-centered viewpoint. It is our desire for students to live lives of faith, character, and service.

Curriculum

To succeed in learning, you need the proper building blocks called curriculum. That's why we use the "A Beka" curriculum for all grades 1 - 6. "A Beka" is a proven curriculum used by more Christian schools than any other. At the heart of "A Beka" is an excellent phonics program used to develop superior reading skills. In upper elementary other Christian curriculum is used for spelling and Bible. We remain committed to using curriculum that is Bible based with a Biblical worldview.

Learning Activities

Elementary students have library, music, art, PE and computer classes as well as field trips. During library students learn library skills. During computer class, students learn basic computer skills and reinforce classroom lessons. The students will begin to study basic music elements such as beat, melody, rudimentary notation, and rhythm in music class. In Phys Ed the students learn basic skills and practice gross motor movement.

Program

The regular school day for a full day student is from 8am – 3pm daily. Students may arrive as early as 6:30am and stay until 6pm in our extended care program for an additional hourly charge.

Hot lunch is offered daily and is prepared in our modern, state certified kitchen. Students may also pack a lunch and purchase milk or juice.

Summer care is offered from June through August through our Summer Camp program. Parents can sign up for the entire summer or by the week as needed.
