Curriculum

To succeed in learning, you need the proper building blocks called curriculum. That's why we use the "A Beka" curriculum for all grades. "A Beka" is a proven curriculum used by more Christian schools than any other. At the heart of "A Beka" is an excellent phonics program used to develop superior reading skills.

The five year old kindergarten program is outstanding. Children will be reading with amazing proficiency, developing cursive writing skills, learning to use capital letters and periods. Their studies include health and human biology and the science of earth and space. K-5 children will learn number words, the value of coins and dollars, telling time, using the calendar, days of the week, addition facts through 10, subtraction, one-step story problems and counting by twos.

Learning Activities

Kindergarten students have library, music, PE and computer classes as well as field trips. During library time students learn various sections of the library as well as enjoying a time when the librarian reads to them in an effort to pique their interest in books and reading. During computer class, students learn basic computer skills and often play various educational games to reinforce previous lessons. Field trips are used as another excellent way to broaden a student's knowledge about the world around them. The kindergarten student will begin to study basic music elements such as beat, melody, rudimentary notation, and rhythm. This will be accomplished through singing, movement and body percussion.
