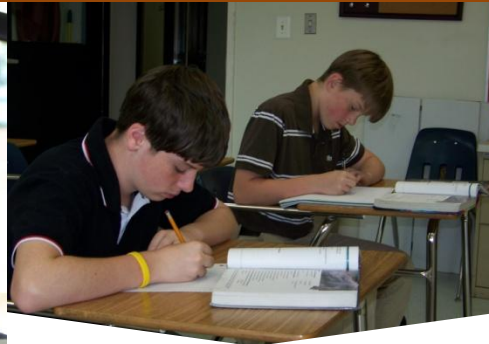


# Emmanuel Christian School- Middle School
